OUR CALLING

After 8 years in the Kansas City metro area, it would have been easy to ignore it. But as Ben fought for his life against Covid in 2022, it became clear that God had a new calling, not only for him, but for our family. We prayed, explored, and waited for whatever it might be. In February of 2023 Ben met for coffee with an old colleague. This trusted man told him "you have the heart of a church planter". He went on to share the need the whole state of South Dakota has for restoration movement churches. After some more prayer and research, we were connected with two church planting organizations. The process has sped along from there. In late July, the NPEA (Northern Plains Evangelistic Association) invited our family to take a trip to the Rapid City area to see what God wanted to show us. We quickly fell in love with what we found. Not only is Rapid City's population rapidly growing, it's proximity to the outdoors can't be beat. This calling was only further affirmed in our assessment with NEXUS in Dallas in early September. It was a weekend that both stretched and encouraged us as we learned more about the gifts God has uniquely given us and the church that God has already planted in our hearts. At the end of assessment, both church planting organizations offered us their support to plant a church in Rapid City, SD. This summer we aim to do just that.


